History: Thin rescue dog, lab work shows hyperthyroid. Wedge biopsies of thyroid submitted.

DIAGNOSIS: Histologically normal thyroid gland, possible enlargement of parathyroid gland.

HISTOPATHOLOGY: Two sections were submitted. The thyroid elements are within normal limits histologically. The cells form follicles that contain colloid. The epithelial cells are all uniform. This specimen includes parathyroid gland. This seems somewhat large, but this could be simply an artifact due to the angle of sectioning. The parathyroid gland architecture and individual cell characteristics are unremarkable.
